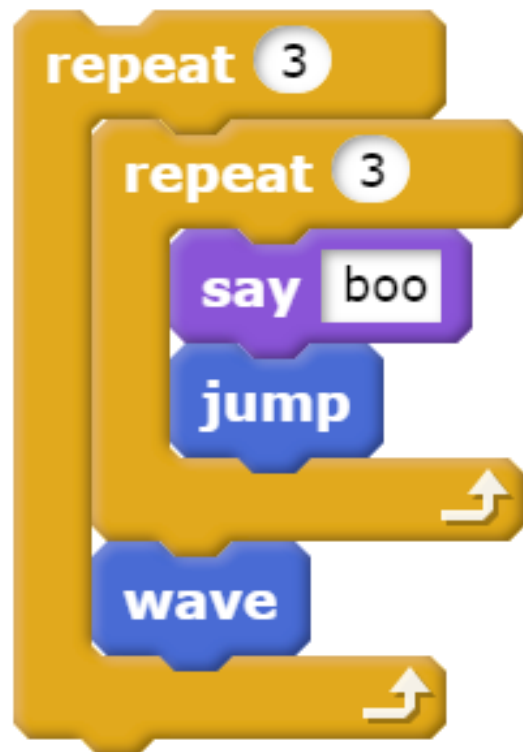


# Nested Loop Formative Assessment Questions

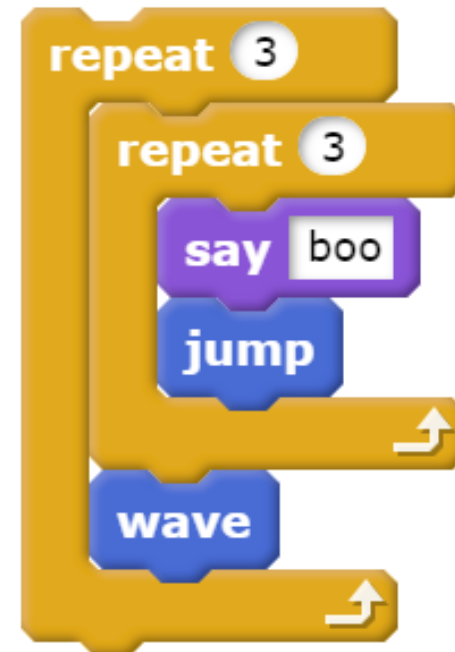
Ask pupils questions to get them to think about the code and how it works.
