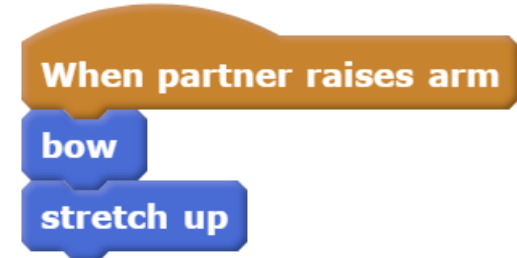
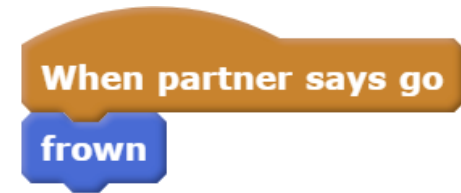


# Simple Input Formative Assessment Scaffold Prompts

These can be used as part of formatively assessing pupil knowledge of inputs. There are simple questions to assess pupil knowledge.
